Dear SISAC member schools,

SSIS Suzhou is happy to be hosting this years SISAC Badminton championships. This event will take place on April 24th, 2010 and will start at 10:00am. Please send your entries by **April 2nd** in order to participate.

Teams

Each school may enter a team of 8 students (4 boys, 4 girls).

Schools must designate players in the following events;

Girls Singles

Boys Singles

Girls Doubles

Boys Doubles

Mixed Doubles

**note changes may not be made to these designations except in the case of an injury.

Tournament Format

- 1) If 8 schools are involved there will be two pools of 4. Each pool will play the other teams in their division and the top 2 from each division will play for the championship, while the bottom two will play for 5th place.
- 2) Individual event championships will be decided by points throughout the round robin matches only. Points from the play offs will not count, however if need be the tie breaker procedure will include any head to head games from the play off rounds.
- 3) **It is important that all teams play the third game in the event of a tie.
- 4) A game between two teams involves a best out of 5 match series as follows:
 1. Girls Singles
 2. Boys Singles
 3. Girls Doubles
 4. Boys Doubles
 5. Mixed Doubles
- 5) All 5 matches must be played out to complete a game between each team.
A game between two teams can be completed using 2 courts in approximately 1 hour including warm up time.

Match Scoring

- 1) Matches are the best out of 3 games using the Rally Point scoring system
- 2) Games are scored up to 15; tiebreak is played at 14-14 where you win by 2 points; if the game is still tied at 20-20 then the winner of the next point wins the game
- 3) Players change ends at the end of each game, and when one side reaches 11 points in the last game
- 4) The side that wins a game serves first in the following game
- 5) Players may take a ½ minute rest between games; players may not leave the court and may not get coaching at this time
- 6) Players may get 1 minute of coaching only between the 2nd and 3rd games of a match, but must stay on court

Order of Play

A schedule of play will be distributed as soon as possible after entries have been taken.

Playoff Structure

The top 4 teams will be ranked using their win loss record.

First round of the playoffs; game # 1 1a vs 2b; game # 2; 1b vs 2a

Final round Loser game 1 v Loser game 2; winner game 1 v winner game 2

The bottom 4 teams will be ranked using their win loss record.

First round of the playoffs; game # 1 3a vs 4b game # 2 4a vs 3b

Final round Loser game 1 v Loser game 2; winner game 1 v winner game 2

Team Ranking and Individual and Team Tie Breakers:

Team win-loss record

Head-to-head results

Games won (minus) Games lost

Points scored (minus) points against

Coin toss

(If at any point during the application of the tiebreakers to a multiple team tie, if multiple teams are separated down to a two team tie, then the head-to-head results will be used to separate these two teams)

Awards

First place and runner up patches for all 5 events (girls singles, boys singles, girls doubles, boys doubles and mixed doubles)

Team trophies for the top 3 teams

Food

Food will be available for purchase throughout the tournament. Water will be available in the gyms. Please remember to bring your own water bottles.
